This Sunday is the **Feast of the Most Holy Rosary**. Throughout the British Isles, the Rosary will be recited in churches, in people's homes and in other locations at 3pm. This '**Rosary Under the Cross**' is being said as an Act of Reparation and Prayer for the well-being of the Universal Church – especially in the light of the abuse scandals and the 'cover-ups' of abuse that have come to light in recent months and years.

*The Rosary will be said in both our churches at 3pm, along with other appropriate devotions.* Please try to come along to church this afternoon. If that is not possible, please say the Sorrowful Mysteries at home at 3pm, in union with this prayer that is being offered throughout the British Isles.

The month of October is traditionally kept as a **Marian Month** and a time when Catholics make a special effort to say the Rosary. As usual, there will be a Marian Hymn at the end of all our Sunday Masses.
