**THE THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER**

Dear Parishioners,

Today's Gospel tells us of the third appearance of the Risen Lord to his disciples – and of the miraculous catch of 153 fish: the assurance to them of his divine power.

During this month of May, the Church traditionally offers special honour to Our Lady. I would encourage you to say the Rosary – not least if this devotion does not normally feature in your pattern of daily prayer. As usual in the Parish, there will be a Marian Hymn at the end of the Sunday Masses.
