This Sunday we celebrate the **SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY**. We adore the infinite Mystery of the shared life and love of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit – the infinite Mystery of life and love that we are graced to share in through our Baptism: our calling is nothing less than to be ‘partakers of the Divine Nature’ (Second Letter of St Peter).

This Sunday the Church observes as the annual **DAY FOR LIFE**. On this day we pray especially for all ‘Life Charities’ and the work of ‘Life’, ‘SPUC’, and other similar organisations that seek to uphold the dignity of human life.

*There will be a 2<sup>nd</sup> Collection at all Masses for Life Charities.*

This Sunday we have the **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION CELEBRATION** at the 11am Mass at St Joseph’s. Please keep the candidates, their parents and their catechists in your prayers.

After the 11am Mass the Candidates and their Families are inviting everyone into the Hall for some special refreshments – and to celebrate together this great day in the life of the children and the life of our Parish.

**There will be a Holy Hour 4pm – 5pm this Sunday** – for the Padre Pio Group and all others who can attend. On this day, members of Padre Pio Groups around the world unite in prayer.

We now return to using the **NICENE CREED** at Mass.

## APPOINTMENT OF THE NEW PARISH PRIEST FOR OUR LADY & ST JOSEPH PARISH:

Bishop Alan has appointed the Revd James Fyfe to be the new Parish Priest in Sheringham and Cromer– he will begin his ministry here at the beginning of September. Fr James Fyfe has been for some years Parish Priest of Wisbech. Fr James began his life as an Anglican – and was a member of the Society of St Francis (Anglican Franciscans). ## NEW APPOINTMENT OF JIM LAIRD:
