On this great Feast Day, we have the opportunity to give thanks to God for granting us the Sacramental Presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ on our Altars and in our Tabernacles.

It is a day when we offer our personal thanks to God for the gift of Holy Communion.

Re-commissioning of Lay Ministers of Holy Communion at all Masses.

Mass at 6pm on Saturday at Our Lady of Refuge

Mass at 9am on Sunday at Our Lady of Refuge – at the end of Mass, Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Mass at 11am on Sunday at St Joseph's. The Procession of the Blessed Sacrament follows immediately after Mass, concluding with Benediction.

The Procession and Benediction, as in the past few years, will be in the grounds at St Joseph, weather permitting!

Please bring a picnic lunch! – tea and coffee will be available in the Hall.

Members of the community at Our Lady of Refuge are warmly encouraged to come over to Sheringham, and join those from St Joseph's for a picnic lunch and some social time together.
